





Dear Immanuel family,

Greetings to you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We are entering into an Advent season. The weather, nature, everything is changing paving the way for another great season of Christmas. Just like the time and season we celebrate Christmas every year, the time of birth of Jesus Christ in this world - the Incarnation, had a certain historical importance. Every year, as we celebrate Christmas, we unknowingly acquire new layers of depth about the story of Christmas - about the Incarnation of Christ. On the other hand, there is even a danger that repeated celebrations can reduce an event to a mere tradition rather than an experience. How do we celebrate Christmas? How does it touch our lives? How is the celebration of Christmas relevant to us and to the world around us? What is the message of Christmas in the changing historical social and religious situations and context around us?

The word of God says - "in the fullness of time God sent his only son"(Gal 4:4) Incarnation has to do with time and context. God who is beyond time and space entered into the realm of time and space through incarnation. John 1:14 says "the word became flesh and dwelt among us filled with grace and truth. We saw his glory ..." Christmas is an experience.

May this Christmas celebration lead us to a deeper experience of incarnation of our Lord and help us to better understand God's purpose in sending his only begotten son for our salvation.

Identity and Liturgy

Last month I gave some sparks about worship and liturgy. We are continuing our journey in the same line. How do we recognize a Christian? How do we distinguish a Christian from his/ her neighbor who may be a Hindu, a Muslim, a Mormon or an atheist? By their dress? By the food they eat? By their social habits? In India, till recent past, the answer to those questions was yes. Christians could be identified from others by their clothes, their food-and the way of life of their community. Now the things have changed. But in our context, in USA, it is very difficult to recognize a Christian by their food habits, Social habits or by dress code. We wear the same clothes, live in the same houses, eat the same food send our children to the same schools as our neighbors who are not even Christians. At home, the main thing that distinguishes us is what we do on Sunday morning- we gather in congregations and worship the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Worshipping is what gives us our identity.

The Syrian Christian community has its identity down the long centuries was the fact that our forefathers and foremothers worshipped differently from the other people among whom they lived. Week by week they met for the celebration of the Qurbana (Holy Communion). Their children were baptized, and their dead buried according to Christian rites. The worship tradition was the primary focus for the separate identity of the community.

In the Scriptures also we see exactly the same. What makes Noah, Abraham, Jacob and the other Patriarchs different is that, they do not worship the gods of the people around them. Instead, they build altars and offer the sacrifices and prayed to the God of Heaven or Yahweh. In Exodus we see God teaches the Israelites how to worship Him. God gave the detailed regulation for constructing the Tabernacle and its contents, and with the rites that the priests and ordinary worshippers are to conduct there. In other words, one of the first things that God did for the people once he had brought them into a separate existence apart from the Egyptians, was to give them a liturgical tradition, and to forbid them to take part in the worship of the other peoples. Their worship was the focus of their separate identity.

In addition, the worship regulations are mixed up with laws for the People of God in their everyday life and regulations for the personal living and cleanliness of every man and woman. In other words, worship isn't to be a separate compartment of people's lives, but is meant to be linked to the way people interact with each other, and with their own personal, private relationship with God.

Jesus Christ did not overthrow the Old Law, he came to fulfill it and he testified to its continuing importance. The fact that Jesus lived a humble, simple life, serving others does not mean that God is no longer majestic, holy, awesome and all the rest. The death of Jesus for us on the Cross means that we all have access to our Holy God.

The beauty of our Liturgy is that, it has all the fundamentals of the Tabernacle worship of the Old Testament times and the essentials of the New Testament worship tradition. Even if we are using the St. James liturgy, the Mar Thoma Liturgy is a reformed one. Almost all the unscriptural elements which affected the integrity of the life of faith and piety, was deleted. Palakunnath Abraham Malpan and Kaithayil Geevarghese Malpan were the two strong pillars of the Reformation of the Malankara Church.

We are celebrating December 21st as the Mar Thoma Church Day. Let us together pray for our Church. Lets be proud of our Mar Thoma Identity.
